

# Certificate in Medical Toxicology



Commencing

4 October 2010

The Certificate in Medical Toxicology is designed for health professionals, including hospital doctors, trainees in clinical pharmacology, biomedical scientists, information scientists and nurses. It is also suitable for those intending to join, or who are already members of, the pharmaceutical industry and those seeking a career in governmental regulatory bodies. The material consists of five three-part modules. Subjects studied during this course include:

Classification and Epidemiology of Poisoning  
Diagnosis of Poisoning

Management of Poisoning (a)  
Management of Poisoning (b)  
Antidotes

Unit 3  
Drugs Affecting the Autonomic System  
Analgesics  
Antidepressants

Unit 4  
Animal and Plant Toxins  
Psychoactive Drugs  
Household Products

Unit 5  
Herbals and OTC Drugs  
Drug and Chemical Abuse  
Information Technology

Candidates who satisfactorily complete the Certificate course may be eligible to study for the Diploma. There is also an opportunity for candidates on this course to attend the three day course organised by the Cardiff and Vale University Health Board.

The Fee for Certificate 2010/11 has yet to be announced but is likely to be in the region of £1,720 (which includes the Recent Advances course).
